School Introduction

Nanjing Foreign Language School Xianlin Campus (also referred to as NFLS Xianlin Campus) was founded in 2002 as a new private boarding school by the Nanjing Government to extend high-quality education resources.

Nanjing Foreign Language School Xianlin Campus is located in Nanjing Xianlin University Town, covering 410 acres, with school buildings occupying an area around 39 acres. The school consists of primary school, middle school (junior and senior high school), and international high school with total 230 classes, over 9400 students, 1249 teachers and staff including 863 full-time teaching staff and 65 foreign teachers.

At Nanjing Foreign Language School Xianlin Campus, we devote ourselves to promoting multiple activities such as classroom reforms, foreign language festivals, arts festivals, reading festivals, science and technology festivals, sports festivals, hikes, concerts, student union representative campaigns, talent quests, lectures, debates, etc. These all enable our students to “learn while they play; play while they learn”. On this campus, we are trying to help every student discover themselves and guide them to the right track.

The International Department of Nanjing Foreign Language School Xianlin Campus was established in 2004, with the establishment of the Sino-American Program, the GAC - ACT program, the Sino-Germany program, and the UFS (Sino-Australia) program in ensuing years.

Every year we have over three hundred students entering prestigious universities all around the world. In the twenty years of our established history, we have undergone an arduous yet glorious path. We have gained a remarkable achievement and become a first-class foreign language school in Jiangsu, as well as a top-rated private school in the entire country.

School Motto

Since the founding of the school, Nanjing Foreign Language School Xianlin Campus has embraced "educational accountability", adopting an exhortation to "Nature Inspires us" as our motto, the ideals of "Democracy, Progressiveness, Openness and Creativity" as our goals, and the mantra "Be aware, Be decisive, Be confident" as our educational framework.

✧ Sino-Germany Program

Back in 2009, Nanjing Foreign School Xianlin Campus was entrusted by the Chinese Union, and with the special approval of the Nanjing Municipal Bureau of Mathematics and Education, the NFLS Xianlin Campus opened the first German high school curriculum class in China (hereafter referred to as the Sino-Germany program). Sino-Germany program students from NFLS Xianlin Campus are able to apply for different majors in all universities without any restrictions.

Furthermore, our students will receive a tuition reduction policy just like other German students. In addition, with the *Abitur* certificate of the German liberal school, students are also able to enter universities in Switzerland, Austria, the United Kingdom, the United States and other countries.

✧ GAC-ACT Program

Starting in 2010, Nanjing Foreign Language School Xianlin Campus introduced the renowned Global Assessment Certificate (GAC) curriculum for international pre-university courses and became the "American ACT Teaching and Testing Center". The GAC curriculum is developed by American College Entrance Examination Board in partnership with over a hundred prominent universities in the United States, Britain, Canada, and Australia, designed for non-English native speakers get admission to universities worldwide.

Curriculum

The GAC-ACT Program in Nanjing Foreign Language School Xianlin Campus is an internationally recognized university preparation program that provides students with academic knowledge, skills, and confidence to thrive in an English-language bachelor's degree program, which also includes AP courses, and the Chinese general high school courses. At Nanjing Foreign Language School Xianlin Campus, we offer courses like English, mathematics, computer, communication skills, study skills, business, science, and other AP courses in English by experienced native English-Speaking teachers.

✧ Sino-American Program

Beginning in the fall of 2013, NFLS Xianlin Campus' Sino-American Program is in active collaboration with Wasatch Academy in central Utah, USA. Wasatch Academy is one of the most celebrated schools in Utah with a history of over 140 years which is accredited by the Northwest Association of Independent Schools (nwais.org) and Northwest Accreditation Commission (advanced-ed.org), fully recognized by universities and colleges around the world.

Wasatch Academy was recognized as a "Private Schools of Distinction 2018" by *Newsweek*. Students at NFLS Xianlin Campus's Sino-American Program study Wasatch Academy curriculum, allowing those who achieve the academic requirements to graduate with a Wasatch Academy diploma, as well as our School Diploma.

Curriculum

The Sino-American program is 3-year long and students in this program are required to take typical American high school courses that are delivered completely in English by experienced native English-speaking teachers in addition to traditional Chinese high school courses that are instructed in Chinese. The American high school courses include English, Pre-Calculus, Physics, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus BC, AP Microeconomics, AP Macroeconomics, AP Physics 1, AP Statistics, AP Chemistry, AP Physics C-Mechanics, Psychology, US History, Computer Science and Applied Design Arts. On the official transcript, these American high school courses are listed separately with blank space above the traditional Chinese high school courses.

✧ UFS (Sino-Australia) Program

Since 2014, Nanjing Foreign Language School Xianlin Campus corporate with the University of New South Wales (UNSW) in Australia and founded the most prestigious pre-university program in China offering students a smooth transition into undergraduate studies.

Students in the UNSW Foundation Studies in China have built up a tremendous track record of success over the past ten years with over 95% of students entering an Australian Group of Eight university, the vast majority matriculating into the top handful of schools in the country. In 2020, over 400 graduates from the program entered direct undergraduate studies into a G8 university including nearly 200 to the University of Melbourne, Australia's top-ranked university.
